

The Atonement Killer

Psalms 10:7-10 shows their tactic is to play off our vulnerability.

2 Corinthians 2:5-11 “Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.”

Functionality of the demonic realm. Demons have purposes and special characteristics. Biblically, they are marked by the function and their name.

Condemnation, shame, and guilt play a role in Christian's lives. They work hand in hand. They hold much influence in the realm of our view of yourself in confidence, courage, self-value, and therefore affecting your faith.

Romans 8 “There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.”

From G2632; *an adverse sentence* (the verdict):—condemnation.

kat-ak-ree'-no

From G2596 and G2919; *to judge against*, that is, *sentence*:—condemn, damn.

Introduce you to a spirit that is hidden. I want to expose a spirit that I believe has robbed many, and is due to be exposed. A spirit of self-blame.

Before I tell you what that spirit does, I want you to understand what Jesus did, and why this spirit is so nasty against your destiny.

The main thing I want you to understand today that Jesus did, is that He paid the price for you by His own blood as the sacrificial lamb.

Revelation 5 says He was the perfect lamb. Paul said He took care of it all. He also said He destroyed the penalty which was awaiting us. (do this while painting a towel on a chair...letting it be sprayed while I share, then share scripture).

He was the lamb.

Col 2:14-15 “Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; and having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it.”

1 Peter 1:18-21 “¹⁸Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; ¹⁹But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: ²⁰Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you, ²¹Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.”

A spirit of self-blame ignores repentance. It's a blabber mouth spirit that taunts.

It's a spirit like a mirror.

It is there to get into your head to get you to think that you deserve punishment.

Though that is true, we have received the removal of that deserved penalty by what Jesus did on the cross!

Here's where many lose what Jesus did on the cross, and why many of them don't grow, get delivered, get better, get free, or get whole, or let God help them, is because they have listened to this spirit, and before they know it, they're sitting on true chair.

This spirit's job is to mock what Jesus did on the cross. It's job is to get you to sit in the place of Jesus and to try to let you settle the penalty for your sins.

Before long, you believe that anything and everything which happens to you is justified and is deserved by you.

Someone paid the price for you!

That spirit is a perverted spirit which is trying to changed the positional purpose of Christ by removing Him from the altar as the lamb of God. And it tries to make sheep of God as sacrificial lambs in the place of the perfect Lamb of God. And that is a perversion.

Romans 5:8-11 “⁸But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. ⁹Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. ¹⁰For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life. ¹¹And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.”

Not only is it not good for you, but it nullifies everything that Christ did for you. Though you are paying a price, your blood cannot change or redeem anything. Though we are guilty of sin, that's the very reason we cannot redeem anything. It takes the blood of the Innocent One. The One without sin. The One Who was perfect.

You have to realize your blood gets you nowhere. When the enemy comes to you, you have to say to him, "Satan, you're wasting your time with me. My blood can get me nowhere. There's only one blood, one sacrificial lamb there's only One Whose blood was shed. Stop messing with me.

You will not get me to sit on the chair of My Lord. That is an altar that makes you an idolatrous object by nature because your try to put yourself in the place of Christ to saw yourself.
